Corrigendum to “Work Interruption Experienced by Nurses during Medication Administration Process and Associated Factors, Northwest Ethiopia”

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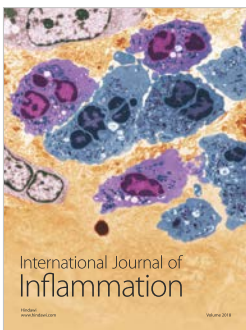
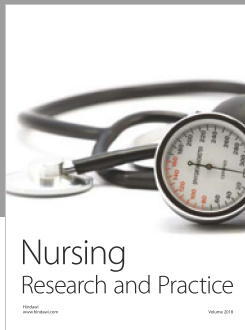
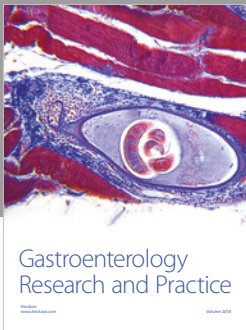
