THE ANT *CATAGLYPHIS BIRMANA* A SYNONYM—  
The specimen described as *Cataglyphis birmana* by Collingwood in 1962 (Ent. Tidskr., 83: 227, figs. 8, 9; type locality Malvedaung, Tenasserim, Burma, 300 m) is a worker minor of *Camponotus singularis* (= *Formica singularis* F. Smith, 1868, Cat. Hym. Brit. Mus., 6: 27; type locality "Java.") *New synonymy*. The type of *C. birmana* was loaned by Dr. Eric Kjellander through the courtesy of Mr. C. A. Collingwood, and has been returned to the Naturhistoriska Riksmuseum, Stockholm.—W. L. Brown, Jr., Department of Entomology, Cornell University.
